1. SIG20 and SIG26 biennial conference 2022



The next SIG20 biennial conference will be jointly organized with SIG26 once more. It will be hosted by Utrecht University in Utrecht, Netherlands from the 14th to the 16th of September 2022. Please mark your calendars.

More details will follow in the coming months. For now, we would like to ask you for ideas on a general conference theme that could fit both SIG 20 (Inquiry Learning) and SIG 26 (Argumentation, Dialogue and Reasoning). We plan to have three keynote speakers during the conference, one for each of the SIGs and one that can bridge between the SIGs and we would like to receive your suggestions for keynote speakers both for our own and for the joint keynote.

We aim to have a face to face conference in order to renew the community feeling for those who attended prior SIG20 conferences and especially for JURE members for whom the conference may be the first in-person point of contact with our community. We welcome ideas for inviting more JURE members to join SIG20.
